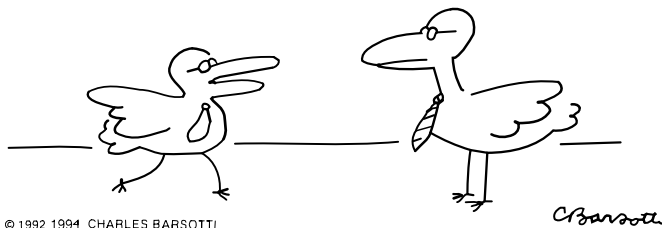

## Hudson River Valley

Late summer is a perfect time to visit the beautiful Catskill Mountains and the historic Hudson River Valley area. We'll visit Springwood, New York, FDR's Home and Museum. "All that is within me cries out to go back to my home on the Hudson River". This quote captures FDR's connection to Springwood, the estate that he loved and the place he considered home. The first US Presidential Library was started by FDR here. FDR was the only President elected to four terms. We'll visit the museum at West Point and tour the academy grounds and Cadet Chapel. Did you know the Hudson River sports a soaring 6,676 foot long, 212 foot high pedestrian Walkway that was created in 2009? It was formerly a 120-year old railroad bridge that's been re-engineered. You'll have the opportunity to walk this beautiful bridge. We'll visit and taste the wines of the Brotherhood Winery, the oldest winery in the United States and a National Historic Landmark. It has been in continuous operation since 1839. We'll spend the night at the new Quality Inn in Fishkill, NY.

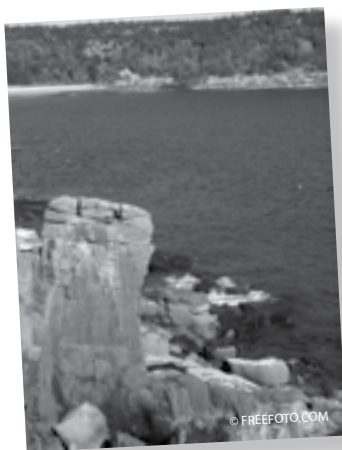

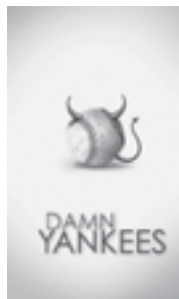

## Frosted Rhubarb Cookies

Just in time for the rhubarb!

- 1 cup shortening
- 1 ½ cups packed brown sugar
- 2 eggs
- 3 cups all purpose flour
- 1 t baking soda
- ½ t salt
- 1-1/2 cup diced fresh rhubarb
- ¾ cups flaked coconut

### Frosting:

- 1 3 oz pkg cream cheese, softened
- 1 T butter, softened
- 1 ½ cup confectioners sugar
- 3 t vanilla extract

In a large mixing bowl, cream shortening and brown sugar. Beat in eggs. Combine flour, baking soda, salt; gradually add to creamed mixture and mix well. Fold in rhubarb and coconut. Drop by rounded tablespoons 2 inches apart onto greased baking sheet. Bake at 350 degrees for 10-14 minutes or until golden brown. Cool for one minute before removing to wire rack to cool completely.

For frosting: In a small mixing bowl, beat cream cheese and butter until fluffy. Beat in confectioners sugar and vanilla. Spread over cooled cookies. Yield: 4 dozen cookies.

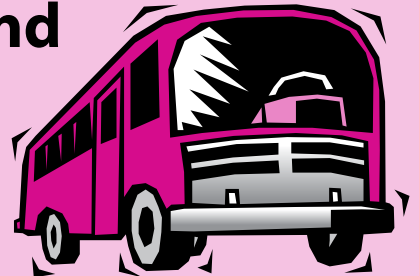
