

The SECURE Act of 2019—*what you need to know*

With relatively little fanfare, Congress recently passed the biggest retirement bill in more than a decade. Called the SECURE Act of 2019, it includes changes that impact retirement savers and their heirs. Here are three of the more significant items from the bill.

Starting January 1, 2020, the age at which you are required to start taking distributions from traditional retirement accounts changed from 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 72. Those who turn 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ on or after January 1 are subject to the new rules. If you were required to begin distributions in 2019 before this new law, you should proceed as scheduled.

The law now allows investors to contribute to traditional IRAs after reaching 70 ½. Under the old law, new contributions were not allowed after this age. Keep in mind, you still need to have earned income to be able to contribute.

Another major change is the manner in which non-spouse beneficiaries receive retirement account money upon the death of the owner. Previously, non-spouse beneficiaries could stretch out the amount required to be taken from an Inherited IRA over the course of their life. This allowed money to be invested for decades past the owner's death and thus receive favorable tax treatment. Referred to as a "stretch IRA", this is no longer allowed. Under the SECURE Act, non-spouse beneficiaries will have to distribute the full balance of the account within ten years.


