No-Bake Pineapple Pie

Ingredients:

- 1 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1 (8 ounce) package of softened cream cheese
- 1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple
- 1 (3.4 ounce) box instant vanilla pudding
- 9 ounce graham cracker pie crust (store bought

Directions:

- 1) In a mixing bowl whip heavy cream to stiff peaks
- 2) Drain pineapple, reserving the pineapple juice.
- 3) Beat cream cheese until fluffy, add reserved pineapple juice and box of instant vanilla pudding.
- 4) Gently fold the crushed pineapple and whipped cream into the cream cheese mixture.
- 5) Spoon the cream cheese pineapple filling mixture into graham cracker pie crust.
- 6) Refrigerate to chill and set up. (This also freezes well, remove from freezer at least a few hours before serving.)
